ENTRY ELIGIBILITY

Any trained, healthy dog 15 months or older may compete in a CPE agility trial. All purebred and mixed-breeds are equally eligible for entry. Bitches in season or any dogs who are blind, lame or aggressive towards people or other animals are not eligible to compete.

EFFECTIVE FOR ANY TRIAL HELD AFTER 01/01/03:

All dogs entered in a CPE agility trial MUST be registered with CPE prior to the host club's trial closing date.

PRIZES AND AWARDS

Ribbons will be awarded for 1st through 4th place for all classes. Teal rosettes will be awarded to all dogs receiving a qualifying score. Dogs getting a new title will receive a title rosette.

We will be awarding a special prize to each team having a perfect weekend (all Q's). This is to recognize those teams who embody the CPE philosophy of consistency. Good luck to all!

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

- ✓ Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the show committee. A refund of all but \$5 will be given for bitches in season. A letter from your veterinarian is required.
- ✓ It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dog(s) and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dog(s) and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the show committee, be asked to leave the show site. In that case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.
- ✓ No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- ✓ Obstacles shall meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of the Regulations for Agility Trials.
- ✓ Exhibitors are responsible for complete, accurate and legible information on entry forms; illegible or incomplete entries cannot be entered in the show.
- ✓ Frank Janson Photography will be on site taking photographs (both action and still shots) both days.
- ✓ There will NOT be a food vendor on site; lunch will be provided for volunteer workers.
- ✓ There will be limited space for RV's at the show site. Sorry, no hookups available. The fee for overnight camping is \$20 a night. Contact Wendy Cerilli (agilitytraining@yahoo.com) for more information.
- ✓ There will be run throughs at the trial site on Friday night before the trial. See entry form for more information.
- ✓ The vet closest to the show site is the Northway Animal Emergency Clinic, off of Exit 18 of the Northway (I-87); (518) 761-2602.

SOME HOTEL COURTESIES TO OBSERVE: Please use care with your dogs in these motels.

- ✓ Cover the motel's bedding with a sheet, whether or not you think your dog will get on the bed.
 - ✓ Make every effort to have your dog free of fleas BEFORE arriving
 - ✓ Of course, as is standard agility procedure, the dog's handler/owner will pick up all poop. Please bag and dispose of it properly. Remember that your motel is an extension of the show site. You must clean up after your dog.
 - ✓ Don't leave your dog(s) unattended. If you must leave, either take them with you, or leave them crated. Even the best dogs(s) can get carried away having fun in a motel room without you present. We WILL request reports from the motels as to the behavior of agility guest and their dogs. Please be respectful of your motel neighbors.

DIRECTIONS TO TEST SITE

From North or South (Saratoga Springs): take Exit 14 of I-87 (Northway) and follow the signs for Rte 29, east. Go 9 miles on Rte 29 to Schuylerville. Take a right at Cumberland Farms. Go 0.3 miles to the light and take a left at the light, following Rte 29. You will pass the Washington County Fairgrounds. 2.7 miles past the fairgrounds, take a right at the Battenkill Vet Clinic onto Rte 40, south. Go 0.3 miles. Take a left onto Bulson at the Elks Club. Go 0.4 miles. Take a right onto Hegeman's Bridge Road, Go 0.2 miles and take a left onto Louse Hill Road. Go 0.2 miles and turn right up the driveway to High Goal Farm.

From South or East, alternate route: Take Route 22 North through the towns of Petersburg and Hoosick. In Cambridge, take a left onto Route 372 West, and follow for 10 miles. Take a left on Hill Street (this is the end of Route 372, it's at a traffic light); follow for 1.4 miles (it becomes Hegeman Bridge Road). Turn left onto Louse Hill Road, follow for 0.2 miles and turn right up the driveway to High Goal Farm.

CPE GAMES DESCRIPTIONS:

Jackpot: The object of Jackpot is to test the course planning strategies of the handler, and the dog's ability to work at a distance. The handler will attempt to accumulate the minimum required points in the first part of the game, then go on to the gamble, hoping for the jackpot.

FullHouse: The object of FullHouse is to successfully accumulate required points for your respective level that includes a pair, three of a kind, and a joker, before the whistle. The timekeeper's whistle will signal the end of point accumulation time. The team then has up to 5 seconds to stop the clock by placing at least one paw on the Pause Table. If the team has accumulated the required points for its level, and the required sets, the team does not need to wait for the whistle to proceed to the pause table to stop the clock & finish their run.

Jumpers: The object of Jumpers is to successfully complete the course within fault limits and course time. The course must include at least the following: 2 tunnels (open or closed), 1 tire jump and Bar Jumps - winged or wingless, ascending double jump.

Colors: The object of Colors is to successfully run your choice of one of the two overlapping mini-agility courses on the same field. The field will contain 12 to 20 obstacles divided into 2 relatively equal mini-courses of 10 to 12 obstacles each.

Snooker: The object of Snooker is to test the course planning strategies of the handler, and the dog's ability to concentrate on and execute the handler's directions. Snooker is run as a two-part game. The first part (opening sequence) consists of the handler and dog attempting a "red" jump (1). If the attempt is successful, the team has earned the right to go on to a "color" of choice, 2 through 7. After attempting or completing the color, the procedure repeats itself until the team has completed 3 "reds" and attempted or completed 3 "colors". The team then begins running the "colors" in numerical order (closing sequence).

Wildcard: The object of Wildcard is to successfully complete the course including enough "wildcards" to qualify. A modified Standard Course will be the base for Wildcard. The course obstacles shall be 10 - 12 obstacles, and 3 choice obstacles.
